

Technical Requirements for Accessing the Online Learning Environment

Online Environment Requirements

To access and participate effectively in Continental Florida University's online courses, students are expected to have regular access to the following minimum technology resources.

Minimum Hardware Requirements

Students must have access to one of the following devices:

- Personal computer, laptop computer or tablet

Minimum System Requirements

- Processor: Dual-core processor or equivalent
- Memory (RAM): Sufficient to support the operating system and required applications
- Internet Connection: Minimum recommended speed of 5–10 Mbps; 25 Mbps or higher is recommended for video conferencing and multimedia content

Supported Internet Browsers

The learning platform is optimized for the following browsers:

- Preferred: Google Chrome
- Also supported: Mozilla Firefox, Microsoft Edge, Safari, or Opera

Recommended Software

Students should have access to the following software applications:

- Word processing software (e.g., Microsoft Word or equivalent)
- Spreadsheet software (e.g., Microsoft Excel or equivalent)
- PDF reader (e.g., Adobe Acrobat Reader or equivalent), installed and updated
- Antivirus software, installed and kept up to date

Audio Equipment

Students are required to have:

- Headphones or speakers
- A microphone

These tools are necessary to participate in online classes, complete coursework, access instructional materials, and engage in any synchronous learning activities that may be required by the course.
